Italian Tortellini Soup from Kris Sible

- 1 pound Italian sausage, browned and drained
- 2 15 oz Italian diced tomatoes
- 4 cups veggie or chicken broth (32 oz container)
- 8 ounces cubed cream cheese
- 20 ounces cheese tortellini (or any flavor)
- 1 bag of fresh spinach
- Season with garlic and Italian seasonings
- Add sausage, broth, tomatoes, cubed cream cheese and seasonings to the crock pot. Cook on low for 4 hours or until pasta is done. Serve with parmesan cheese on top
